How to Register for an Early College Dual Enrollment Course

Registration is Quick and Easy! Just follow these steps:

- [Go to fdupes.edu/ec](https://fdupes.edu/ec)
- Click on **YOUR HIGH SCHOOL'S** name from the list below
 - Click **Select** to enroll in a course
 - Then click on **Add Section**
 - Repeat this process for each course
 - Then choose **CLICK HERE TO COMPLETE YOUR REGISTRATION**
 - Select **Submit**
 - And then **Check Out**
 - After checking out, please access your email account for the **Confirmation Message** to verify that your registration is complete.
- When you receive the confirmation message, follow the steps to set up your **FDU Student Account**.

To retain access to FDU student account after graduation, students must register with their own personal email address. Please do not use a parent or family member email address since messages may not be received.

FDU EARLY COLLEGE DUAL ENROLLMENT

With FDU's Dual Enrollment Program, you can take credit-bearing FDU courses right at your own high school with other classmates. Courses are open to eligible students in grades 10 to 12.

- The college credits you earn can be applied toward your high school graduation requirements.
- These credits will also be accepted toward an undergraduate degree at FDU and most other two- and four-year colleges and universities.
- Courses are taught by high school teachers at your school, using a college-level syllabus and other materials provided by FDU.
- You'll save time and tuition cost by getting an early start on your college studies.
- Set yourself up for success with an Early College course that can raise your class standing and GPA.



FDU EARLY COLLEGE SUMMER

Fairleigh Dickinson University's Early College Summer Program offers you the choice of engaging, interactive courses that tackle challenging topics and explore emerging career opportunities.

- Choose classes that are asynchronous online, in-person at FDU or remote with Zoom.
- Shortened 3- and 6-week class formats let you earn up to 9 or 12 college credits that can be applied toward an undergraduate degree at FDU and most other two- and four-year colleges and universities.
- Classmates include students from throughout New Jersey and beyond.
- You'll gain college and career readiness skills, and explore college and career pathways.



EARLY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Students who successfully complete at least one Early College class and ultimately enroll right after high school graduation at FDU as a first-time, full-time student will automatically receive a **\$2,000 annual scholarship**. This award is annually renewable for a total value of \$8,000 and is in addition to other scholarships and financial aid. Students also receive early conditional acceptance, and their application fee is waived.
